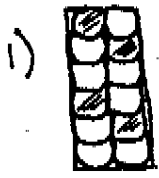



Egg Carton Spider



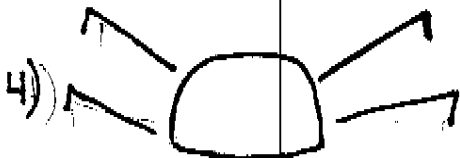
Cut egg carton into individual cups. Paint pieces desired black on both sides to make the body 



Using above pattern, cut out 4 legs, using black posterboard or cardboard painted black. You may also use pipe cleaners.



Using a sharp knife or razor blade, cut 4 slits as shown. Should be as wide as the tab on the leg. For pipe cleaners, punch a hole large enough to put them through.



Insert tabs into slits, making sure outer part of leg touches the table.

Use wiggle eyes or buttons to complete spider.

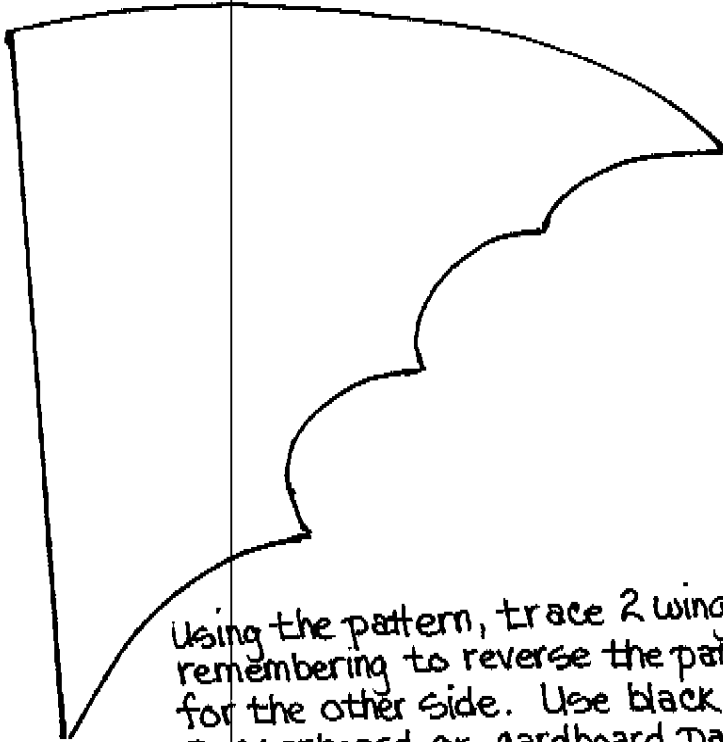
Toilet Paper Bat

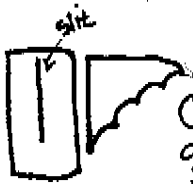
Paint toilet paper roll black, inside & out.

Using the pattern, trace 2 wings, remembering to reverse the pattern for the other side. Use black posterboard or cardboard painted black.

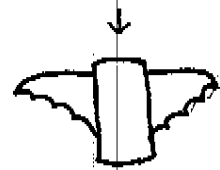


Cut a slit on each side of roll, starting approx. $\frac{1}{4}$ " from top. Lay wing against roll at $\frac{1}{4}$ " mark, & end your slit approx. $\frac{1}{2}$ " above bottom tip of wing.

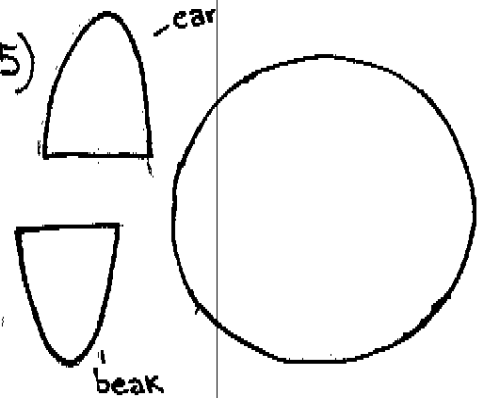

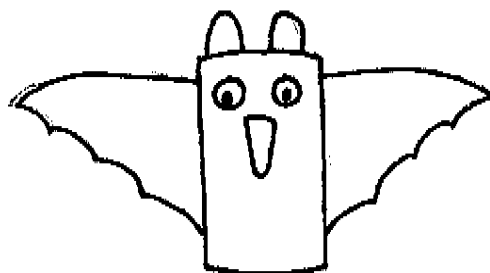
Insert bottom tip of wing into bottom of slit, sliding down until top of wing is even w/ top of slit. Insert remaining wing & adjust for evenness on both sides.

Cut out 2 ears from black posterboard & glue on inside of front of roll, approx $\frac{1}{4}$ " in front of wing. Use round pattern for top of head (optional). Push into top of roll until it lays on wings. Use wiggle eyes or cut small circles from white or orange posterboard. Use candy corn for beak, or pattern.








PLASTIC 2-LITER BOTTLE CAT






- For body, remove cap from 2 liter soda bottle, clean and paint black.
- For head, paint a toilet paper roll black.
- Using pattern, cut out 2 cat eyes on black posterboard. Then cut the iris out and trace on orange or green construction paper and glue on eye as shown on pattern.
- Using pattern, and black posterboard, cut out cat ears, remembering to reverse pattern for 2nd ear.
- Using pattern, cut out cat nose/mouth on black posterboard.
- Use pattern for collar (make any color on construction paper) and ID tag (use different color than for collar).
- Use black pipe cleaner folded in half for cat tail.
- Use pattern for cat paws, using black posterboard.

Head

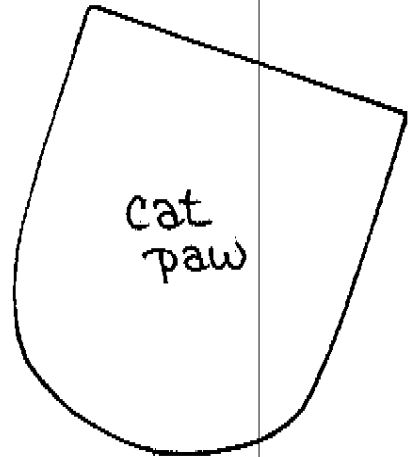
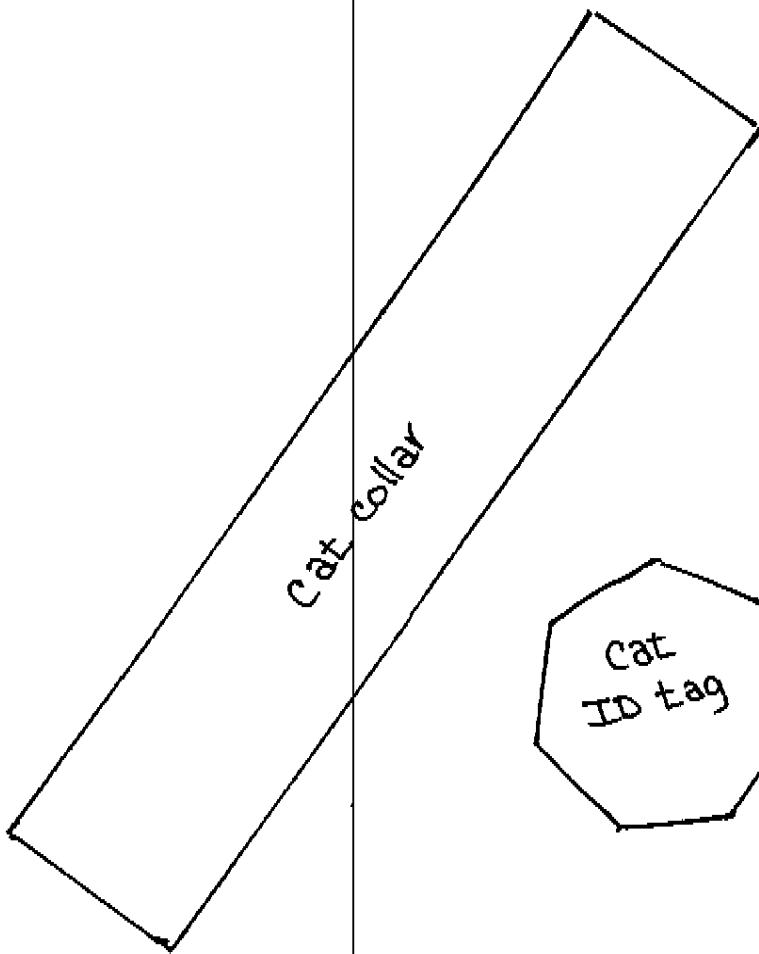
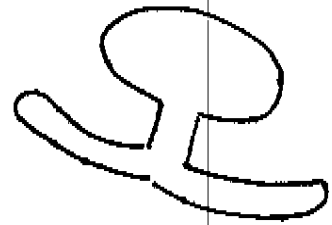
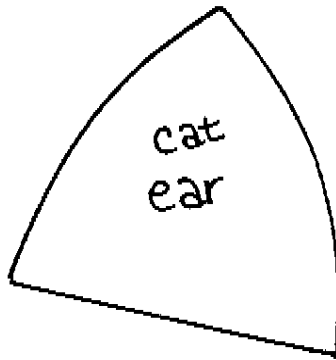
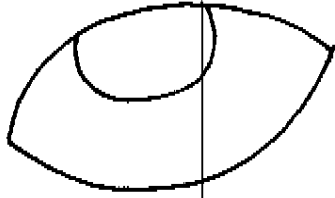
- Cut 1" round hole in toilet paper roll. 
- Cut 2 slits in top of roll, width of cat ears. Slip ears into slits and adjust.  
- Glue eyes in position on front of roll, align with ears. Glue bottom only so eye will stick up. 
- Glue nose/mouth centered between the eyes. Glue only the nose, allowing the mouth to hang below roll. 

Body

- Glue collar around neck of bottle. Cut off excess paper before gluing. 
- Center ID tag and glue 1/2" above bottom of collar 
- Glue paws 6-1/2" from bottom of bottle. 
- Glue end of pipe cleaner tail to back of bottle. Wrap around and glue again so tail sticks out on the side. 
- Glue head on neck of bottle. 
- OPTIONAL: use small pieces of cotton batting for chest and end of paws.



Cat Patterns



COFFEE CREAMER BOTTLE WITCH

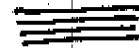
Use International Delight creamer bottle - remove cap, clean and spray black. The indentations on the bottle should be on the sides to form the body of the witch.



- Use one painted egg cup, preferably one with a seam. Put seam facing front to look like witch nose.



- Using black construction paper, cut a piece 6" long, 1/4" wide. Cut into narrow strips for hair.



- Using black construction paper, use pattern to make top of witch hat. Take straight edges of pattern and overlap them until peak is formed. Glue together.



- Using black construction paper, trace pattern for brim of witch hat (circle). Cut out inner circle.



- Using black construction paper, trace pattern for witch cape.

- For arms, use a black pipe cleaner and cut in half.

- To make broom handle, use 2 black pipe cleaners and twist together.

- For broom bristles, use black construction paper and cut two pieces, each 2" wide and 4" long, angled. Cut into narrow strips, leaving 1/8" - 1/4" at the top.



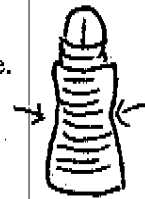

To Assemble:

1. Glue egg cup to top of bottle, making sure seam faces front and bottle indentations are on the side.

2. To put hair on head:

- use quick dry adhesive glue. Put glue on head, and lay the strips side by side.
- using glue gun, glue strips down on side to lay hair down.



3. Place hat on head and glue on.

4. Place hat brim over top of hat, and push down until snug.

5. Place cape around back of bottle and glue to back of "shoulders".



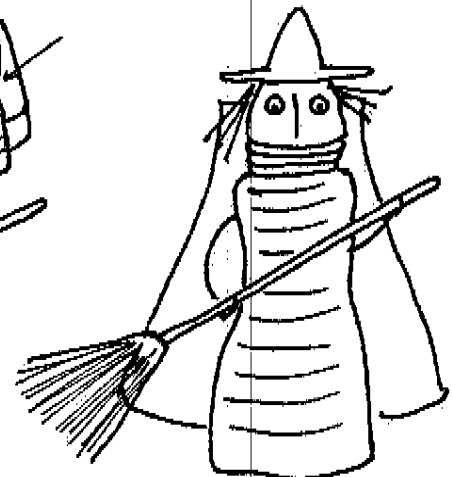
6. Glue arms on both sides.

7. Glue broom bristles to end of broom handle, one on each side.

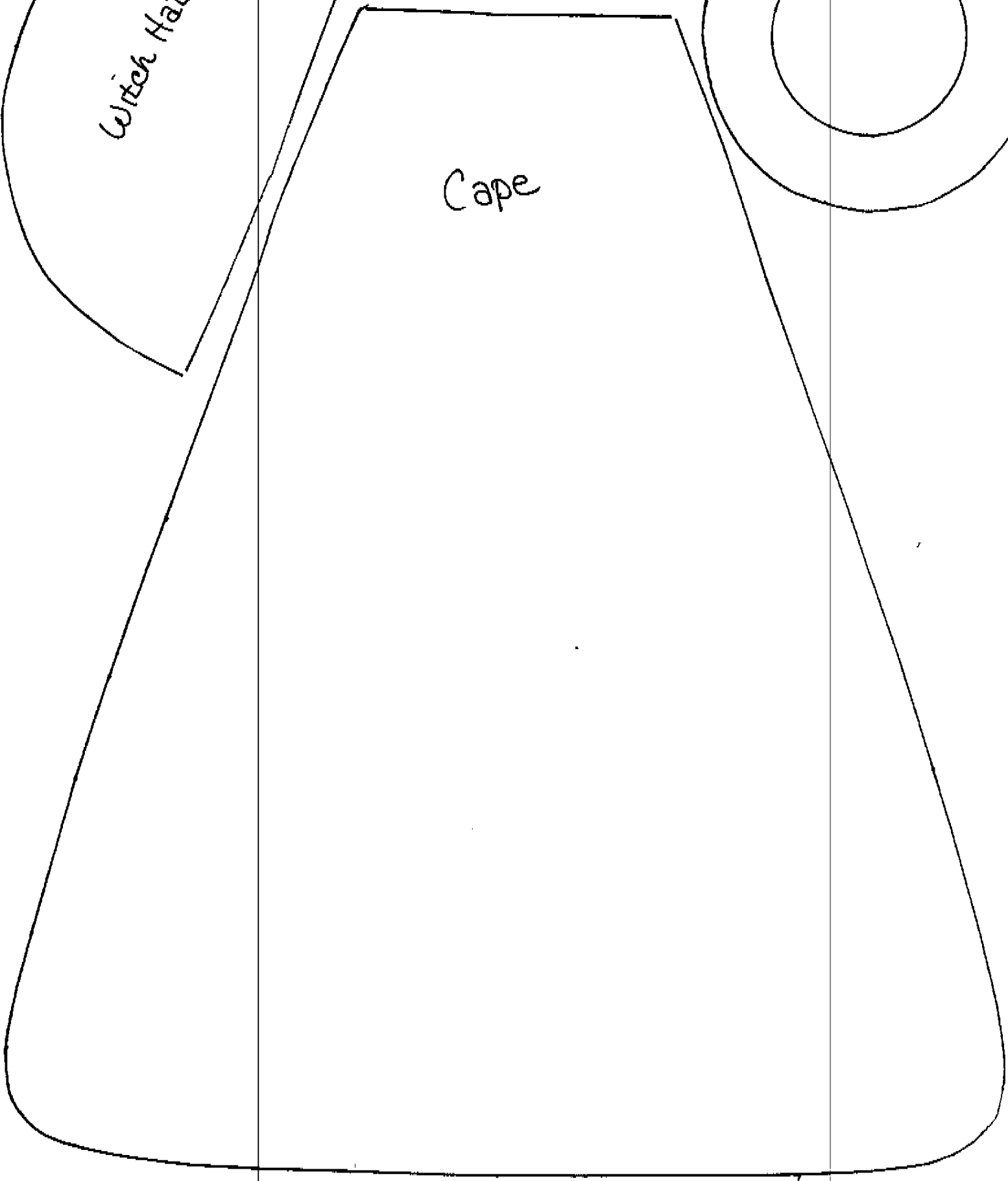
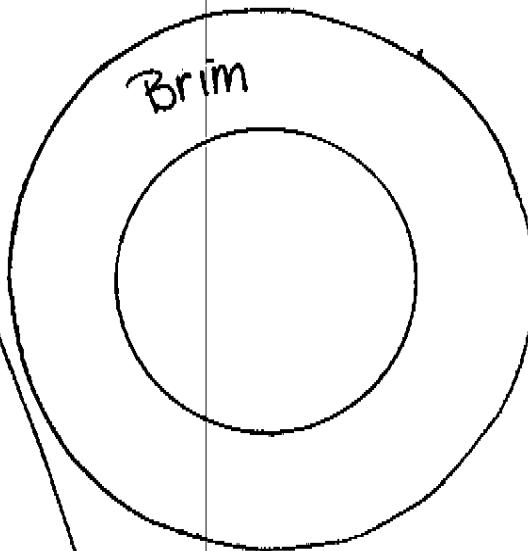
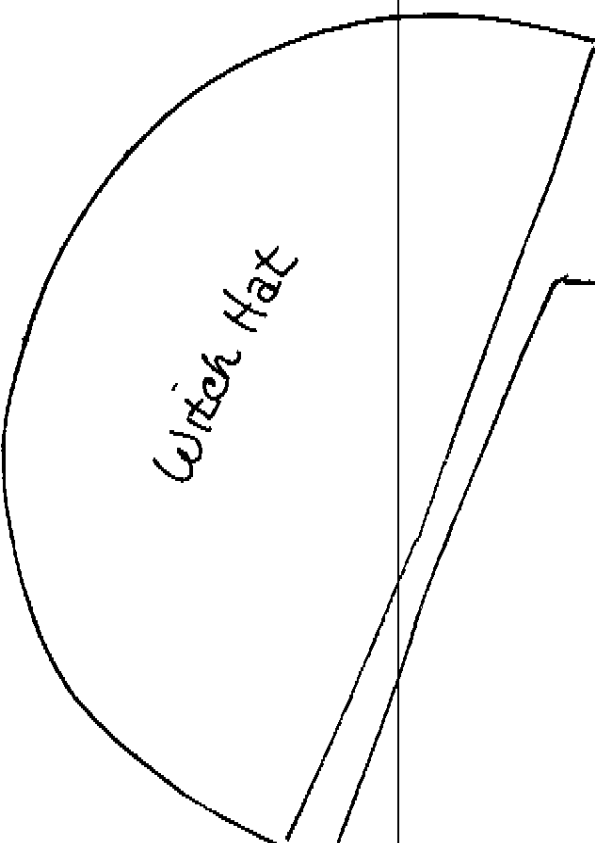


8. Use wiggle eyes for witch eyes.

9. Wrap pipe cleaner "hands" around broom.



Witch Patterns

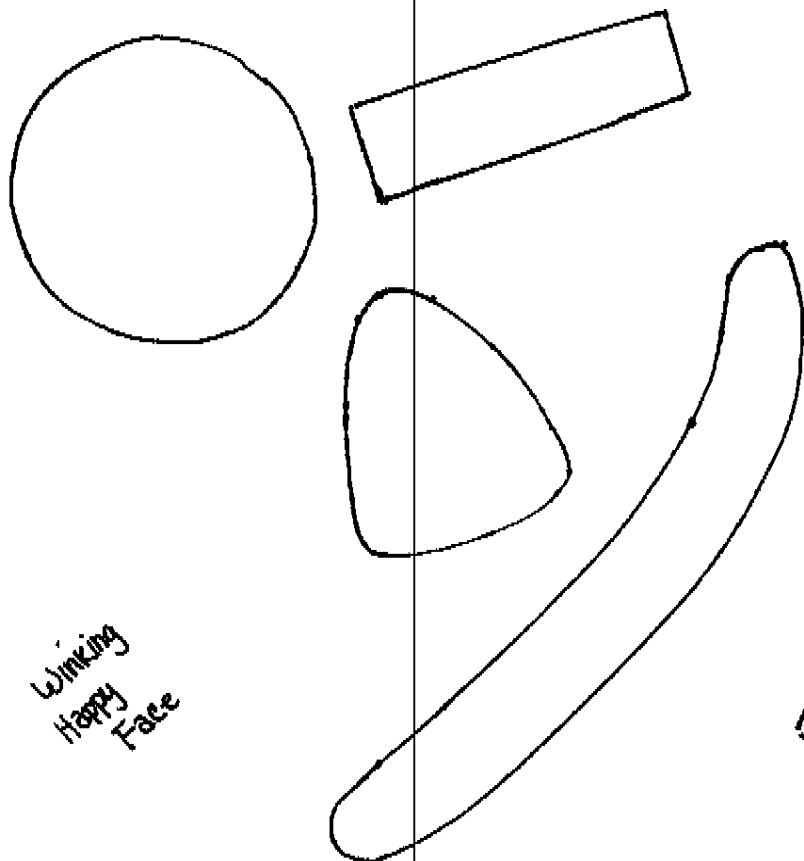


Plastic Milk Carton Luminaries

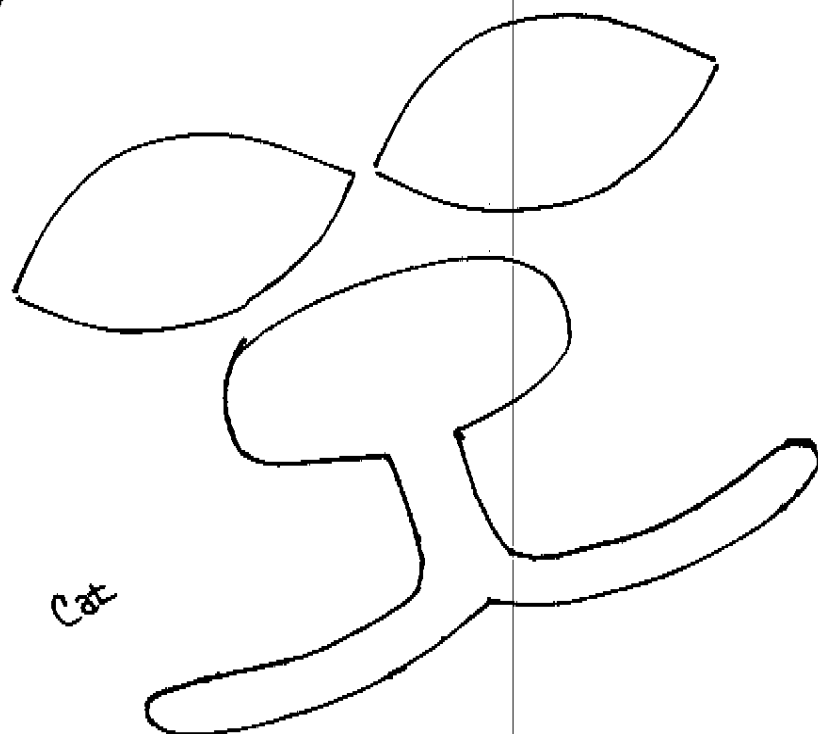
Using the patterns below & on the next page, trace onto clean & dry plastic milk cartons. Use black felt tip pen to fill in eyes, nose, mouth, & to add funny eyebrows.

On the back of each carton, approx $1\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom, use a sharp knife or scissors to cut a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " round hole.

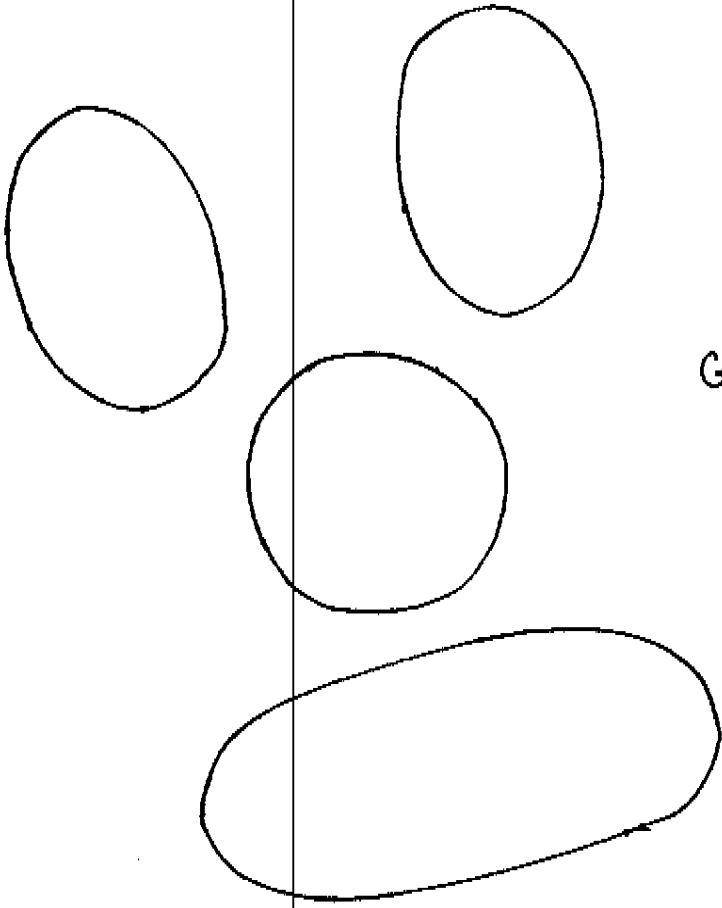
Place finished luminaries a foot apart, in a straight line, or group them together. Using small Christmas lights, place 7 or 8 in the hole in the back of each carton.
